



COVID-19 PATIENT INFORMATION

During this unprecedented time, the Physicians' Surgery Center is doing its part to keep our patients and our staff safe. We wanted to inform you of the steps we are taking at the Center to provide you with the safest possible surgical experience.

- We have increased the frequency of cleaning, especially focusing on areas that are high touch.
- Along with proper hand hygiene, you may see our staff wearing masks.
- Our Pre-Anesthesia Department will contact you prior to surgery. They will ask you screening questions about your current health status.
 - If you are having symptoms of COVID-19 (Cough, shortness of breath, fevers, chills, sore throat, or a recent new loss of taste or smell), let the Pre-Anesthesia nurse know at the time of the call, and be sure to contact your doctor.
 - If you develop symptoms after you have spoken to the Pre-Anesthesia nurse, please call your surgeon immediately and DO NOT come to the Center.
- The Drop-off and Pick-up area is the circle at the East entrance.
- Our staff will call you the day before surgery to give you your arrival time.
- Wearing a mask or face covering will be optional during your time at the Center.
- One visitor will be allowed inside the Center. The exception is that two parents may accompany a pediatric patient or caregivers and family members of disabled patients.
 - Please be sure to have the phone number of the person driving you home.
 - We ask that your responsible party be able to pick you up in a timely fashion after being notified that surgery is complete.
- Your discharge instructions will be reviewed with you and your responsible party prior to leaving the center.
